

Prof. TERESO S. TULLAO, JR. is a professor of economics, Director of the Center for Business and Economic Research and Development, and former Dean of the College of Business and Economics at De La Salle University-Manila (DLSU). He was educated at DLSU (AB, 1973), Stanford University (AM, 1974), and at The Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy, Tufts University (MALD, 1980, Ph.D., 1982).

He has been teaching for more than three decades at De La Salle University-Manila. He was a visiting professor and scholar at various academic institutions in Japan, USA, China, Thailand, France, and Laos.

He has published several articles, monographs and books in Filipino and English on various topics including globalization, trade in services, movement of natural persons, regional integration, economics of education, and the intellectualization of Filipino.
