Professor Ra received his Ph.D. in international relations from Cambridge University. His early career was as Professor of Political Science at Kyunghee University in South Korea. From 1996 to 1998, he played a key role in the first peaceful change of government through electoral process in Korea. He also served as the Director of Administration in the Kim Dae-jung Presidential Transition Committee. During President Kim Dae-jung's time, Dr. Ra served in the post of First and Second Director of the Republic of Korea's National Intelligence Service. During the administration of President Roh Moo-hyun, he also served as Senior Advisor to the President on National Security.
