- Submit an application form as well as an abstract of the paper you will present at the Summer Institute.
- Deadline for the submission of necessary documents: May 31, 2011.

- The abstract should be a maximum of 250 words, including your name, affiliation, paper's title, and the subject category to which you are applying. Abstracts will be judged on strength and coherence of argument, originality, appropriate use of methodology, and knowledge of existing debates.
- The successful applicants should submit papers. The total word count of the paper should be  $5,000 \sim 10,000$  words. The paper will be passed to the professors before the start of the Summer Institute. The deadline for submitting the papers is July 20, 2010. The best papers will be considered for publication in *Asian Regional Integration Review*, Vol. 4 (2012), published by GIARI, Waseda University.
