- the challenge of Asia's growth to status quo strategies







- projections to 2020






Asia and Projected Output Shares at Market Exchange Rates








Asia and Projected Output Shares at PPP






Asia and Projected World Trade Shares







Asia and Projected Intra-Regional Trade Shares






Regionalism in Asia

- regionalism as an economic and political instrument






Architecture of Cooperation: Membership
